EYE CARVING 101

This handout presents basic eye carving techniques in ten easy steps.



Draw two curved lines.





Cut the lines in with a V-tool.





Cut new line in with a V-tool.






Cut the chip out on the side of eye.






Cut the chip out on the other side.






Draw the pupil.






Cut in the pupil.






Use a gouge to form the lower lid.






Use a pencil or paint to make the iris.





Cut from the eye to the top curve with a V-tool to form the top lid.
